“He built a house in which the whole world can live.”

“Fight! Without fight, where is life? If there is no fighting, then what is that life? That is dead stone. Fight must be there. Kṛṣṇa’s whole life is fighting from the very birth. . . . If Kṛṣṇa is fighting, why not Kṛṣṇa consciousness the same thing? You cannot expect peaceful life. No, there must be fighting; then think, ‘That is Kṛṣṇa’s presence, His fight.’ So this fighting means they’re feeling the presence of Kṛṣṇa consciousness movement. Otherwise why they’re making fight? Had it been an insignificant thing, there was no question of fighting.”

November 2nd, 1976—Śrīla Prabhupāda encouraging visitors to join with him in countering the legal attacks on his movement in America by deprogrammers and disgruntled parents.
